2 Minutes of 11th October were agreed.

3 Matters arising.

Bramley PC had cancelled their presentation at this meeting but had confirmed 2nd November at 7.30pm. BJ offered to provide a projector as well as screen.

4 JD reported on the meeting with Ed Rehill and Emma Betteridge that morning. Actions arising from this.

a) JD will prepare the Strategic Environment screening form for return to Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council as soon as possible.

b) JD will prepare the Basic Conditions Statement and Housing policies.

c) Timetable for pre-submission consultation stage. It was agreed that instead of having an Open Day in February, it would be part of the pre-submission consultation process, the information having been sent out to all parishioners at least a week before. NL will provisionally book the VH for the evening of 10th and morning of 11th February. The Pre-submission consultation process starts once the residents and statutory consultees receive the information and lasts 6 weeks for responses.

JD has already asked the Parish Council to allow the NPWP to hire the village hall and a sum for printing and ancillary costs. (£1000) This will be on the PC meeting agenda on 9th November.

5 Updates to the draft Plan

a) BJ will remove the details of the questionnaire summary and replace with short text version.

b) AS will look at photographs for inclusion in the plan.

c) VR will enquire about the possibility of designating some Council (Parish and County) land as Local Green Spaces.

d) JD will prepare wording for the A33.

e) PD will continue updating the policies, key conclusions, glossary, environmental issues.
