

Tree no 1 - Willow in the middle of the island. This is misshapen and at risk of splitting and collapse.

Proposal- pollard by at least 50% (subject to advice from Foremost) to reshape and reprofile.

Tree no 2. - Oak with roots partly in the water and partly in the bank.

Proposal - Fell.and clear.

Tree no 3 - Group of 3 willows alongside the footpath, which are all showing signs of splitting and cracking.

Proposal - Fell and clear.

Tree no 4 - Small untidy oak sapling on the bank edge.

Proposal - Fell and clear.

Tree no 5 - Tall damaged Cherry bare on one aspect - located on very edge of bank.

Proposal - Fell and clear.

Tree no 6 - Willow clump on edge of bank adjacent to the road, - already part pollarded.

Proposal complete pollarding of remaining 3 shoots.
