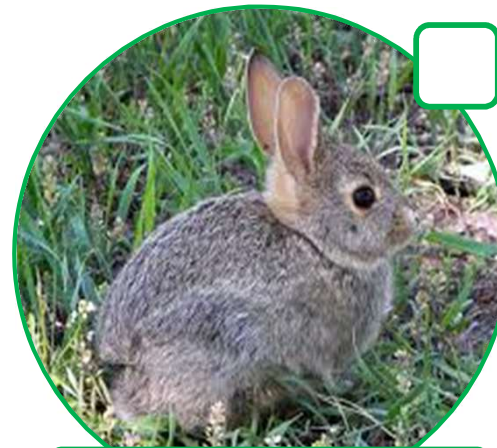

Here are some interesting facts...



The best way to tell the difference between a frog and a toad is that a frog jumps and a toad walks.

Frog



Ducks eat seeds, acorns, berries, plants, insects and shellfish. Bread is very bad for ducks and can kill them.

Duck



Moorhens spend most of their time in water but can fly and even climb trees. They do not have webbed feet but very long toes.

Moorhen



Coots rely on leg power to help them take off by running along the surface of the water in a process called "spattering".

Coot



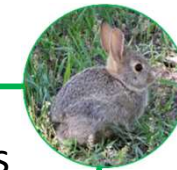
Snails hibernate which means they sleep when the weather becomes very cold. They can sleep for as long as three years.

Hérons are the tallest bird in the UK and their wingspan is nearly 2m. They build their nests very high up in trees.

Heron



Happy rabbits jump up in the air and twist and spin around. Their teeth never stop growing.

Honey bees use the "waggle dance" to tell each other about the direction and location of food.
